GETTING TO DOWNTOWN FROM THE AIRPORT

747 Shuttle Bus

The Hotel Bonaventure is located closest to stop 5.

The 747 shuttle bus line service runs 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, between the Montréal-Trudeau airport and downtown Montreal. There are 2 route options available from the airport:

1. Destination Terminus Lionel-Groulx: One single stop. Travel time varies from 25 to 35 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

2. Destination Centre-ville (downtown): 11 stops. Travel time varies from 45 to 70 minutes, depending on traffic conditions. See stops below.

Wi-Fi service is available on most 747 buses.

The cost of a one-way ticket is \$10. At the P.-E.-Trudeau airport, there are 4 fare vending machines in the international arrivals area. You can purchase a ticket there.

Payment in cash, by debit card or with VISA or MasterCard credit cards are accepted.

If paying CASH directly on the bus, **only Coins are accepted, no bills.** It also provides travelers with a transit pass valid on the STM bus and metro network for the next 24 hours.

Taxi

The airport also has a taxi stand. You can get a taxi or limousine at the arrivals level near the central exit located in front of the cloakroom, where a dispatcher will assist you. No reservation is required. A taxi to downtown is a fixed fare of \$40 plus 10-15% tip.

Uber

Available from door 8 on the departure level.

GETTING AROUND MONTREAL

Clean, safe and comfortable, the underground subway system, called the METRO, is an ideal and economical way to reach many of Montréal's attractions. You can also connect to the city bus system with the same fare. There are so many different transit fare options from a 1-day pass for \$10 CAD, unlimited weekend pass for \$13.75 CAD and a 3-day pass costs \$18 CAD. Take note that the last 2 passes are valid on the 747 shuttle bus. Tickets can be purchased in the metro. For more fare options, see: http://www.stm.info/en/info/fares/transit-fares/3-days

BiXi is Montreal's public bike system. You will see many stations of bikes along certain streets when you go around town. They are accessible to everyone, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Instructions on how to use them are located at every station. The first 30 minutes are included in the system access fee of 7\$ and then usage fees are charged. Tap the "settings" button (3 vertical periods at the top of your screen). Click on "Add to Home Screen".

How to view abstracts

Go to online detailed program: http://guide.wcume2017.org/ Select parallel session or workshop of choice, then click on talk titles to display the abstracts OR Simply type name of presenter or any keyword in "Search" box. Once the search results display, click on the abstract title.

How to build your own agenda

Go to online detailed program: <u>http://guide.wcume2017.org/</u> At the top, click on Login. Then enter your username and password that you would have used to register (and submit an abstract, if applicable).

To select your presentations of interest, click on the star.

If you wish to view all your selected presentations, you click on "My Agenda" at the top of the page. You can then print or email your agenda.
